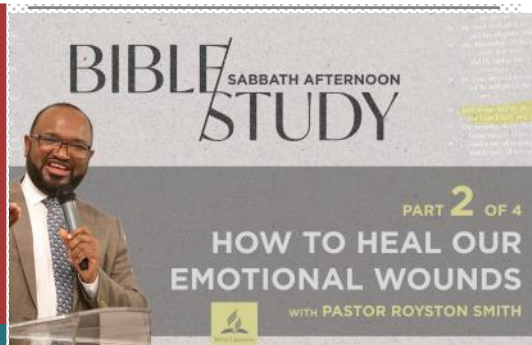

KEEPING CHURCH SAFE AFTER 19TH JULY 2021

- ✓ We encourage people to wear face coverings (except those exempt)
- ✓ Continue to sanitise your hands on entry and exit
- ✓ Temperature checks will continue to be done on entry
- ✓ Pre-booking to attend is no longer required but your name and contact number will still be taken on entry
- ✓ Congregational singing is allowed
- ✓ Social distancing will reduce from 2 metres to 1 metre.
- ✓ Livestreaming will still continue for those self-isolating or sheltering
- ✓ We encourage people to socialise and mingle outside in the nearby park and not in the church building itself.
